

Come and hear about our proposals for Hill Farm, Sharnbrook!

Redrow and Bellway are hosting an information event on our proposals for land at Hill Farm, Sharnbrook, and we would be pleased to invite you to attend.

Our plans seek to provide a quality, residential led scheme of up to 500 new homes, provision of land for formal and informal open space, woodland planting, construction of new as well as improvements to existing highways, a community hub, primary school and associated green infrastructure.

The site, shown outlined in red on the image to the right, has been allocated as part of the Sharnbrook Neighbourhood Plan, formally made by Bedford Borough Council in November 2021, which was subject to extensive community consultation.

Following on from our Outline Planning Application, we have now submitted a new Full Planning Application to Bedford Borough Council on our proposals, which closely align with the Neighbourhood Plan policy and provide more detail in connection with the appearance, scale, setting and layout of our proposals.

We are hosting an information event to present our proposals to the local community, provide an update on our progress to date and answer any questions that you have.
